October 13th, 2018

The Coronado Cougars def. the Liberty Patriots 30-0 at Liberty HS

Joshua Ashley scored 2 touchdowns to lead the Coronado Cougars to victory as the Cougars clawed their way past the Patriots this weekend. Ashley scored on an 18-yard TD pass from QB Tyrese Smith and he also scored on a tremendous 31-yard run. Also scoring for the Cougars were, Parker Tomsik on a 16-yard TD pass from QB Smith, Isaiah Bottley on a 2-yard blast, and Christopher Dalina on a 4-yard run. The Cougars offense rushed for 109 yards with Joshua Ashley gaining 68 yards. QB Tyrese Smith passed for 64 yards with Parker Tomsik catching 3 passes for 3 yards. On defense, Emilio Castaneda recovered a fumble and Robert Adams had 2 sacks. The Patriots were led by Champ Kapanui with 45 yards rushing and 21 yards passing.
