The #1 Seed Las Vegas Aces defeated the #2 Seed Las Vegas Wolverines 37-12 at Green Valley High School in the Championship Game

The fans were yelling “LETS GET READY TO RHAMBO,” and Rhambo responded with touchdowns runs covering 5, 58, 54, and 13 yards. Also scoring for the Aces were, Jacarlos Rodgers on an 8-yard run and Jeramiah Nichols on a 11-yard run. The Wolverines scored on a 24-yard run by Vincent Lopez and a 5-yard run by Khamari Jones. The Aces offense rushed amassd 313 yards rushing behind tremendous blocking by their offense line. Edward Rhambo rushed for 219 yards on 21 rushes and Jacarlos Rodgers and Jeramiah Nichols combing for 60 yards rushing. For the Aces defense, Jayln Bilbrew had an interception and Elijah Harris recovered a fumble.
