May 19th, 2018

The #1 Seed Las Vegas Badgers defeated the #2 Seed Desert Oasis Jr. Diamondbacks 41-6 at Liberty High School

In a game that featured the MVP winner Bishop Allen and MVP Runner-Up Jai'shon Bradford, it was Bradford that stole the show as his Badgers clawed their way past the Diamondbacks to claim a Nevada State Championship. Bradford scored 5 touchdowns in a humongous effort to power his team past the Diamondbacks to victory. The Diamondback struck first on a nifty 26-yard run by Bishop Allen for a 6-0 1st quarter lead. The Badgers answered back with a 10-yard run by Kenneth Hill and with a 1-point conversion by Bradford took a 7-6 lead. In the 2nd quarter the Badgers went wild scoring 4 touchdowns on 39, 23, and 1-yard TD Runs by Bradford as well as Bradford passing 12 yards to Nathan Fletcher for a touchdown and a 33-6 lead. In the 3rd quarter Bradford scored on a 10-yard run to extend the Badgers lead to 39-6. In the 4th quarter the Badgers put the icing on the cake with a 15-yard run by Bradford the win. The Badgers offense pounded the rock 35 times for 292 yards with Jai'shon Bradford gaining 178 yards on 18 totes.
