#1 Seed DO Jr. Diamondbacks (9-0) VS #2 Seed Liberty Patriots (8-1) – 10U *NEVADA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME*

The final day of the Spring 2019 Season kicks off with what should be a thriller of a matchup in the 10U Division as two powerhouse teams face off in what beckons to be a tremendous game. These two teams enter this game really rolling along. The Diamondbacks not only completed the regular season with a perfect record but impressively followed that up with a pair of playoff victories over the Falcons Hit Squad and Bullhead City Firebirds these past two weekends. The Patriots are riding and equally impressive run. After losing their season opener, they managed to rally for 6 straight regular season victories. The Patriots then added to their winning streak in the playoffs with impressive victories over the Bishop Gorman Jr. Gaels and TMT Elite to earn this matchup with the Diamondbacks. These two teams didn't see each other during the regular season, but that doesn't mean that the rivalry between these two association isn't real. The Diamondbacks come into this Nevada State Championship Game boasting the divisions top offensive and defensive units today. The Diamondbacks offense has averaged over 28 points a game to this point while they give up just 4 points a game to their opponents. Those numbers over the Diamondbacks past 9 games are certainly a recipe for success. The Diamondbacks feature several impressive rattlers on both sides of the football including guarterback Bishop Allen, running backs Jose Jaime, Treven Eddington, Javion Gunter, and Yancey Perine. Each of these players has more than 5 scores to their name this season to this point, so that makes for one unpredictable and challenging offense to slow down. The Patriots are led by guarterback Kaden Cadang, top receiver Marley Ganiron, and running backs Trent Tufele, Treyton Savea, and Ezra Sanelvi. #1 Seed Silverado Hawks (9-0) VS #3 Seed Falcons Hit Squad (7-2) – 12U *NEVADA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME*

Where: Liberty HS When: 10:45 AM Our final day of football here in the Spring 2019 Season continues with action in the 12U Division as the Silverado Hawks look for face off with the Falcons Hit Squad in what should be an epic midair battle between these two avian foes. It's been quite the ride to this point for both talented teams. The Silverado Hawks managed to soar through their regular season without any blemishes on their record including a big 40-6 victory over this Falcons team. They then followed that up with impressive victories over the Henderson Cowboys and TMT Elite here in the playoffs. The Falcons meanwhile had a bit of a rough go in the middle of their regular season as they suffered back to back losses to the Firebirds and Hawks at the midway point. They did however manage to bounce back nicely as they recovered with a pair of victories to close out the regular season and two more even more impressive playoff victories to earn this chance in the Nevada State Championship. The Falcons fought through tough matchups with the Sun Devils and the Firebirds showing off how dangerous this team can be when firing on all cylinders. The Hawks and Falcons certainly present an interesting and intriguing matchup come Saturday as they do have some very similar tendencies. Both teams feature stellar passing games. Hansell-Fotu certainly has an array of stellar backs and receivers to utilize including perennial MVP candidate Donavyn Pellot, Torrell Thomas, and Marcus Council Jr. The Falcons Balderrama certainly has his share of talented skill players at his disposal including MVP Finalist Trey'Shaun Jackson, Kelson Wong, Dawson Levine, and Dakari Jackson. Let's take the similarities between these two teams one step further! They are easily the two teams with the best kicking games. Adrian Carnero and Jeau Vinatieri are difference makers with their legs and the outcome of their 2point kick attempts and any field goals will probably decide this very even matchup. When looking at the numbers and averages for these two teams this season, the Silverado Hawks stats really show why they are undefeated to this point. The Hawks average a divisional best over 30 points per game on offense while they give up fewer than 4 points a contest. The Falcons stats meanwhile are certainly impressive as well. The Falcons have averaged 25 points a game to this point but have shown a bit of vulnerability on the defensive end as they give up nearly 12 points a game to their opponents. Well, all the stats, previous matchups, streaks, and histories can all be thrown out here however as things will all play out Saturday morning in this thrilling matchup with the big Nevada State Championship Trophy going to the team puts together the most complete football game.

For the past year these two teams have been going back and forth with every matchup coming down to the wire. Their Fall 2018 Nevada State Championship victory came by a score of just 6-0 in a game that could have gone either way. #1 Seed DO Jr. Diamondbacks (8-0) VS #3 Seed Las Vegas Wolverines (7-2) – 13U *NEVADA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME*

Game 4 of the day will feature what should be yet another stellar Nevada State Championship Game this Saturday afternoon at Liberty High School. The Desert Oasis Jr. Diamondbacks enter this matchup with the Las Vegas Wolverines as the top seed and an undefeated top seed at that. The Diamondbacks rattled their way through a perfect regular season including an 18-7 win over these Las Vegas Wolverines back on April 6th thanks to a talent laden roster. The Diamondbacks were certainly tested this past Monday night in the semifinals as the North Las Vegas Mustangs nearly managed an epic comeback. In the end however, the Diamondbacks were able to hold onto the semifinal victory and earn their spot in this Nevada State Championship Game. This Diamondbacks team has a ton of leaders, but guarterback Jamieon Windham and running backs Fazion Love, Rocco Drougas-Gallings, and Jeremiah Adams make for one very tough team to face. #1 Seed TMT Elite (8-0) VS #3 Seed Arbor View Jr. Aggies (7-2) – 13U *NEVADA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME*

The final contest of the Spring 2019 season will of course feature our 14U Division as the Arbor View Jr. Aggies look to challenge TMT Elite in what should be a fantastic matchup. Both teams are LOADED with NYS veteran talent as many of these kids have been here for

years flashing their talent and growing as players. For most of these kids, this will be their final youth football game before they head off to the next level of High School Football. While we wish them luck at that next level, we are excited to get to watch these kids one final time on our field here at Liberty High School with the Nevada State Championship going to the victor. The top seeded TMT Elite enter this contest red hot. This team completed a perfect regular season, but was certainly a tested group. They had multiple close games, including a close 26-12 victory over these Aggies during the regular season under their belt.
