### **Desert Oasis Diamondbacks (1-0) VS Liberty Patriots (1-0) – 7U**

This has potential to be the best game of the afternoon. Both teams served donut victories on Opening Weekend. The Liberty Patriots left no doubt when Manokekai Guerzon rushed for 2 TD's on 87 yards. He wasn't alone though. The Patriots racked up 226 yards rushing with help from multiple backs. The DBacks rolled off victories in every division on Saturday. They had several weapons that contributed to their offensive attack including Thomas Keenan who lead all RB's in NYS Fantasy Football with 3 TD's. Jacoby Briscoe also got to the century mark with 123 yards. We're gonna pull up a chair and grab some popcorn cause this one is gonna be good.

### **Las Vegas Union (1-0) VS Las Vegas Tribe (1-0) – 7U**

Things are going to get poppin' early at Bonanza HS when these 2 camps lock up for a full slate of games in almost every division. The appetizer to wet the palate is a good one in the 7U Division. The Union rushed for 265 yards on Opening Weekend when Frank Starks, Kareem Knox, and Terrell Collins each scored. Collins might be the most talented 7U back in the league. It's gonna take the entire Tribe to try to shut his legs down. The Tribe can move the ball as well. They rushed for 213 total yard behind Devin Conway & Aaron Wright. Look for A LOT of offense in this one. Just the start to a great day of football at Bonanza on Saturday.

### **Falcons Hit Squad (0-1) VS Sin City Spartans (0-1) – 7U**

This game will feature 2 teams coming off shutout loses in the Opening Weeked. The Falcons return to NYS was not a happy one in Week 1 for the 7U squad who ran into a great Union team. The bright spot for the Falcons was their running game. They were able to move the ball behind great efforts by Kaiston Wong and Thrasher Burns who combined for 86 yards. The Spartans also ran into a really good Desert Oasis DBacks team who held them to just 59 total yards. Look for the Spartans to rely on Maliick George and De'ovian Bryant on the ground. Defensively the Spartans can cause havoc with their ability to force their opponents to turn the ball over.

They're a hard team to stop. They get great blocking up front. The Badgers started on the wrong side of the scoreboard in Week 1 and are looking for a redo in Week 2. Look for the ball to get in Elijah Tuilaepa's hands a lots for the Badgers. He's coming off 21 carries for 133 yards. Look for Vegas Strong to depend on their workhorse RB Malakai Boykin to get it going on the ground.

Unfortunately, things stalled out in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half offensively and they never could catch the Cowboys. The DBacks had an Opening Weekend bye to start the season while watching the rest of the camp complete the sweep. Coach Cedric Allen's reputation as a mad genius on the football field showed in the other age divisions, we'll see if he can get the 8U squad a W as well. The Pahrump Trojans have several new coaches on their staff this season that are helping lay the foundation the correct way. They're teaching the boys the proper technique and fundamentals to be successful. Big things are ahead for the Trojans who have incredible support from their fan base. This is a squad that's going to be dangerous when they start putting the pieces together.

Alright. We're gonna say it... The Union Thunderbirds are really, really good. They can put up a lot of points on the board in a hurry. They're loaded with weapons. Whether it's RB Trey'Shaun Jackson (130 yards rushing Week 1), Eric McFarland (75 yards rushing Week 1), or QB Aidan Crawford (50 yards passing) with the ball it's bad news for whoever they play. They can hurt you in a lot of ways – including Special Teams. Their one weakness that the Tribe may exploit could be in the secondary though. The Falcons were able to connect on a couple of chunk yardage passing plays including a 60 yard TD pass. The Tribe will try to rely on their playmakers such as Rickey Burrell to find holes in the Union TBirds defense.

Just about the time it's starting to get really hot outside things are gonna heat up on the field at Desert Oasis. This 10U Matchup could be one of the best games of the day. 2 really well-coached squads that are coming off nice Opening Weekend victories. The Diamondbacks have a pair of dangerous skill position players in Bishop Allen and Evan McMihelk who each scored 3 touchdowns last week. QB Bishop Allen is a problem. He can put the ball in the air or take off and find open space (68 yards rushing and 47 yards passing). He causes a lot of heart burn for Defensive Coordinators. It's "LV Wolverines vs. Everybody" though. They don't care what team is on their schedule they're gonna line up and come right at you. Last week their defense held Green Valley to -26 yards in a shutout victory. Their offense struggled to really get going despite some good runs by Charles Buckner & Anthony Donato. We don't know but we can't wait to see.

They speed you up, hit hard, and strip the ball as good as any team in the league. Centennial's QB Brayden Harper and RB Ty Haney will work hard to protect the football and find ways to break Vegas Strong's defense down.

### **Elite Las Vegas Wildcats (1-0) VS Henderson Cowboys (0-1) – 14U**

For the Bulldogs they'll rely heavily on their passing attack. QB Victor Plotnikov (137 yards passing Week 1) loves to find his favorite target in WR Kohlman Smith (4 receptions for 84 yards Week 1). Can Vegas Strong Blue stop the aerial arsenal of the Bulldogs? Will Vegas Strong Blue's stable of studs be too much to handle? Kick is scheduled for 1:30pm at Chap.
